Haewon Shin is the principal of **lokaldesign**, and an Adjunct Professor at the Korea National University of Arts. She is a graduate of YONSEI UNIVERSITY, Seoul and the ARCHITECTURAL ASSOCIATION, London. Before she opened **lokaldesign** in 2006, Haewon Shin has taught and practiced in London, Berlin and Hong Kong. Her representative works include Han River Underpass Projects, Happy School Project, and Gwangju Sajik Park Public Art Project. Her work has exhibited at the Venice Architecture

Biennale 2006, Aedes Gallery, the MAK Vienna, and she was awarded 2013 Young Architect Award in Korea. **lokaldesign** focuses on and has been working on meaningful changes that can be created when architecture is incorporated into public and everyday space. The projects that **lokaldesign** has been working on are the outcome achieved from the research on social and cultural background based on understanding of the environment and the adoption and experiment of new technologies in the design process.
